# Report on the suggestion of the betterment of school activities :-

## 1. Diagnostic classes for school students:-

About 80% students of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> classes were very conscious and serious in their studies. The students are aspected as their master foundation skills in the practical work and cultural activities but nearly 50% of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> classes can't read and understand English in a proper way.
